Programs with fewer than 30 graduates or less than 10 employed with full-time wages are not included in this report. Employment and earnings data are based on FETPIP's published reports for 4th quarter (Oct-Dec) of 2024 wages within Florida. This report does not include students employed outside of Florida, those who entered the military, or were self-employed. Cells with + are shown to indicate programs where median salaries are high, but employment rates are low due to job placements outside of Florida, according to Board staff analysis of U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics data. Full-Time Employed is defined as earning at least minimum wage for 13 weeks (\$6,760). Full-Time Annualized Wages are calculated by multiplying the Full-Time Threshold by 4. Cells filled with '****' are masked where there are fewer than 10 students present within a group that is continuing education. Cells filled with '-----' are masked where there are 0 students present within a group that is continuing education. Values equal to 0 are suppressed with (-) for numeric values. Continuing education outcomes are based on enrollment data for the fall semester of 2024 and preliminary winter/spring semester of 2025 and include enrollments in Florida public and private colleges and universities. High school diploma includes employment data for standard high school diploma completers from Florida public schools who did not continue their education. Students may be in multiple settings which may exceed total unduplicated count.
