Legislative Overview



Guardian Program

- Universities may establish a guardian program for faculty & staff

Safety Awareness

- Mobile suspicious activity reporting tool
- Training for students & staff

Information Sharing

- Sharing behavioral threat assessment information

Campus Safety

- Active threat response & reunification plans
- Threat management teams
- Annual risk assessments

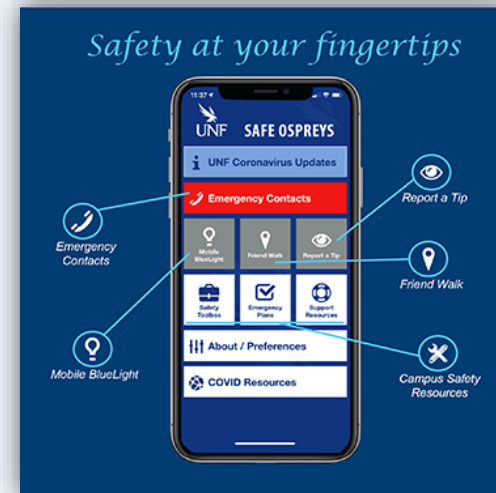
Coordination

Coordinate implementation across the System & with Florida DOE



Best Practices

Leverage existing System practices to ensure all campuses are safe



Consistent Implementation

Ensure consistent implementation of all provisions of the law



Progress to Date

System Campus Safety Workgroup



- 1 **July 2026** Collected & reviewed current university practices
- 2 **July 13, 2026** Transfer of student records
- 3 **July 27, 2026** Transfer of student records & threat management
- 4 **August 10, 2026** Threat assessment tool, risk levels, & security risk assessment
- 5 **August 17, 2026** Finalized risk levels & discussed security risk assessment

Mental Health

Provide annual mental health training for staff & make mental health resources available to students

School Guardian Program

May participate in the School Guardian Program & must follow the appropriate procedures

Mobile Suspicious Activity Tool

Adopt & promote a public safety reporting application & install it on all electronic devices

Response Plans

Adopt a variety of response plans focused on supporting faculty, staff, & students

Reporting Requirements

Submit university certification annually

Campus Risk Assessment & Threat Management

Section 1006.601, Florida Statutes



Campus Safety Risk Assessment

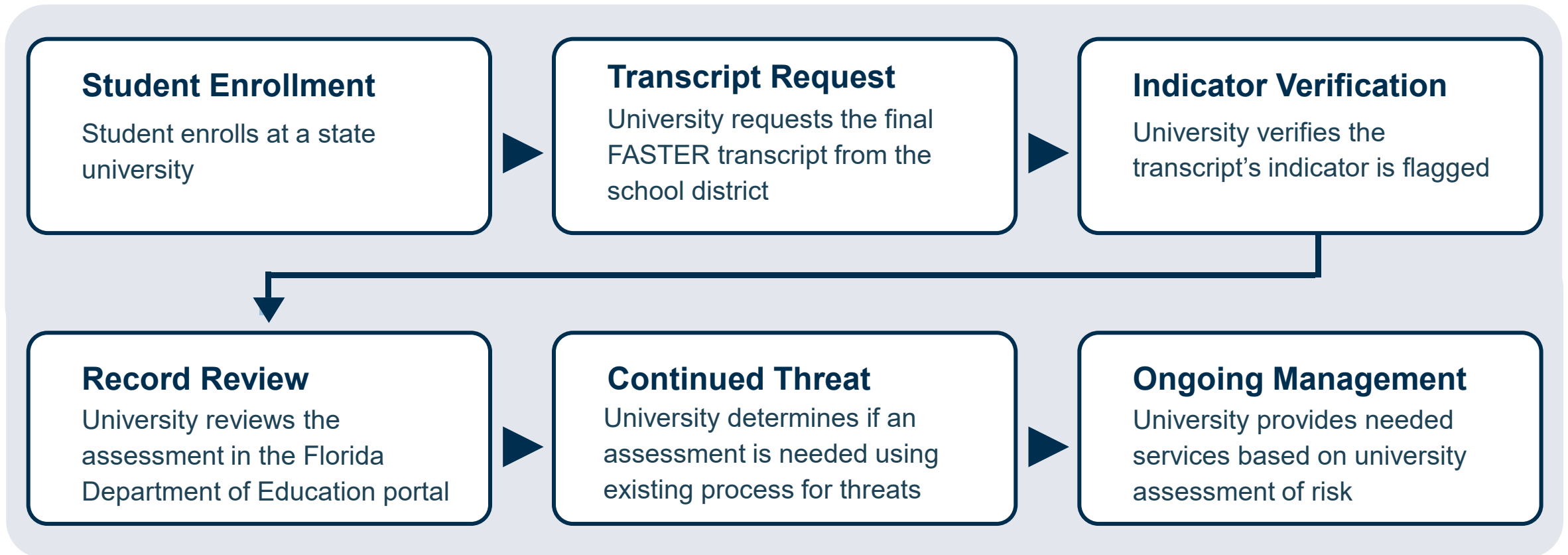
- Conduct an annual university-wide risk assessment
- Coordinate with public safety agencies
- Use Board approved criteria
- Submit the assessment annually to the Board

Behavioral Threat Assessment & Management

- Establish threat assessment & management teams
- Train team members annually
- Adopt procedures & assessment instruments
- Use Board-approved criteria & threat levels

Transfer of Records Process: K-12 to SUS

Behavioral Threat Assessment Records



Transfer of Records Process: Postsecondary Behavioral Threat Assessment Records



Record Review

University receives behavioral threat assessment from prior institution & reviews it

Continued Threat

University determines if an assessment is needed using existing process for threats

Ongoing Management

University provides needed services based on university assessment of risk
