## Program Background




World Class Faculty 8 Scholar Program Established to fund and support the efforts of state universities to recruit and retain **exemplary** faculty and research scholars

Intended to elevate the **national competitiveness** of Florida's state universities through faculty and scholar recruitment and retention

## Program 2018-19 Expenditures

Most (95%) World Class Faculty and Scholar funds supported faculty and research





## Key Metrics



#### Institutions reported

- **improving national rankings** by as many as 14 positions in a single year
- recruiting over **310 new faculty** (FTE)
- retaining over **1,600 existing faculty** (FTE)
- transferring roughly \$92.9 million in research funding to the institutions
- having more than \$299 million in research proposals under development or review

## Program Background





### Program 2018-19 Expenditures




Most (67%) of the funds from the Professional and Graduate Degree Excellence Program were used to recruit and retain faculty and support student success initiatives

#### Institutions reported

- spending to enhance & support medical, law, & business programs
- **increasing** the % of graduate-level graduates working in Florida and earning more than \$40,000
- **advancing** in the national rankings
  - UF & FIU law schools both improved by 10 slots in one year
  - USF medical school increased in the rankings
  - FSU, UF, & USF graduate business schools also improved
