## World Class Faculty & Scholar Program

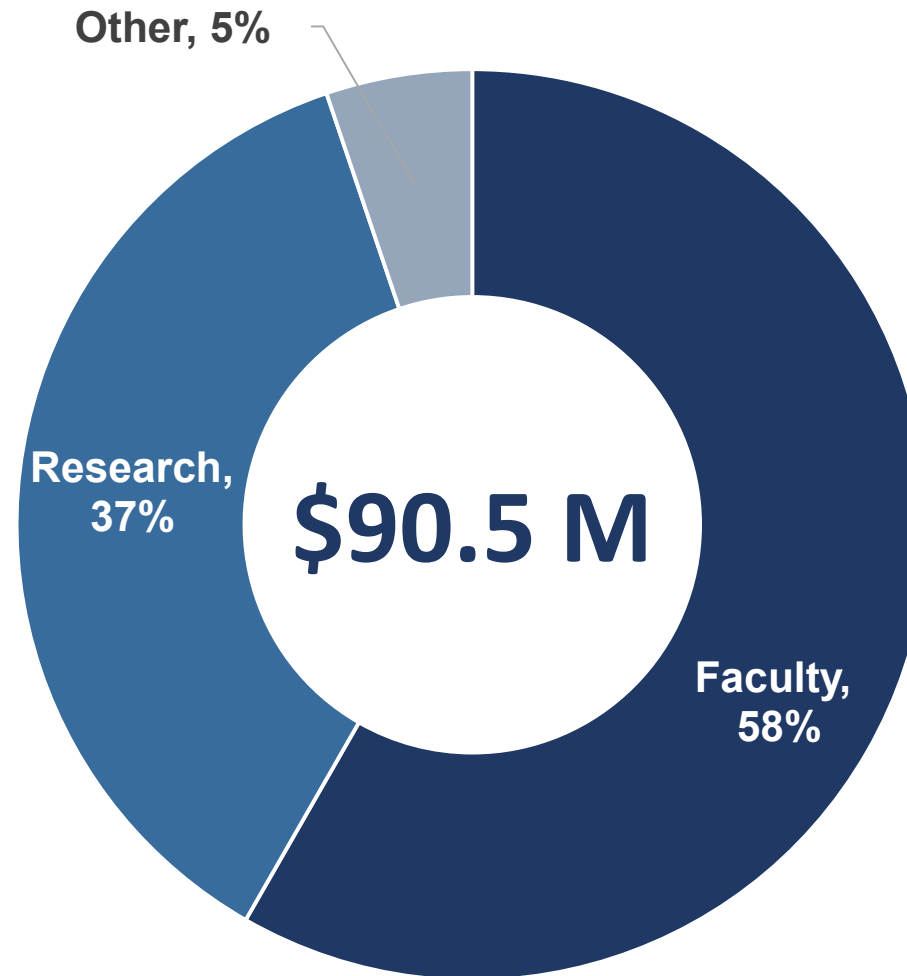
Established to fund and support the efforts of state universities to recruit and retain **exemplary faculty** and **research scholars**

## Institutions reported

- **improving national rankings** by as many as 14 positions in a single year
- recruiting over **310 new faculty** (FTE)
- retaining over **1,600 existing faculty** (FTE)
- transferring roughly **\$92.9 million in research** funding to the institutions
- having more than **\$299 million in research** proposals under development or review

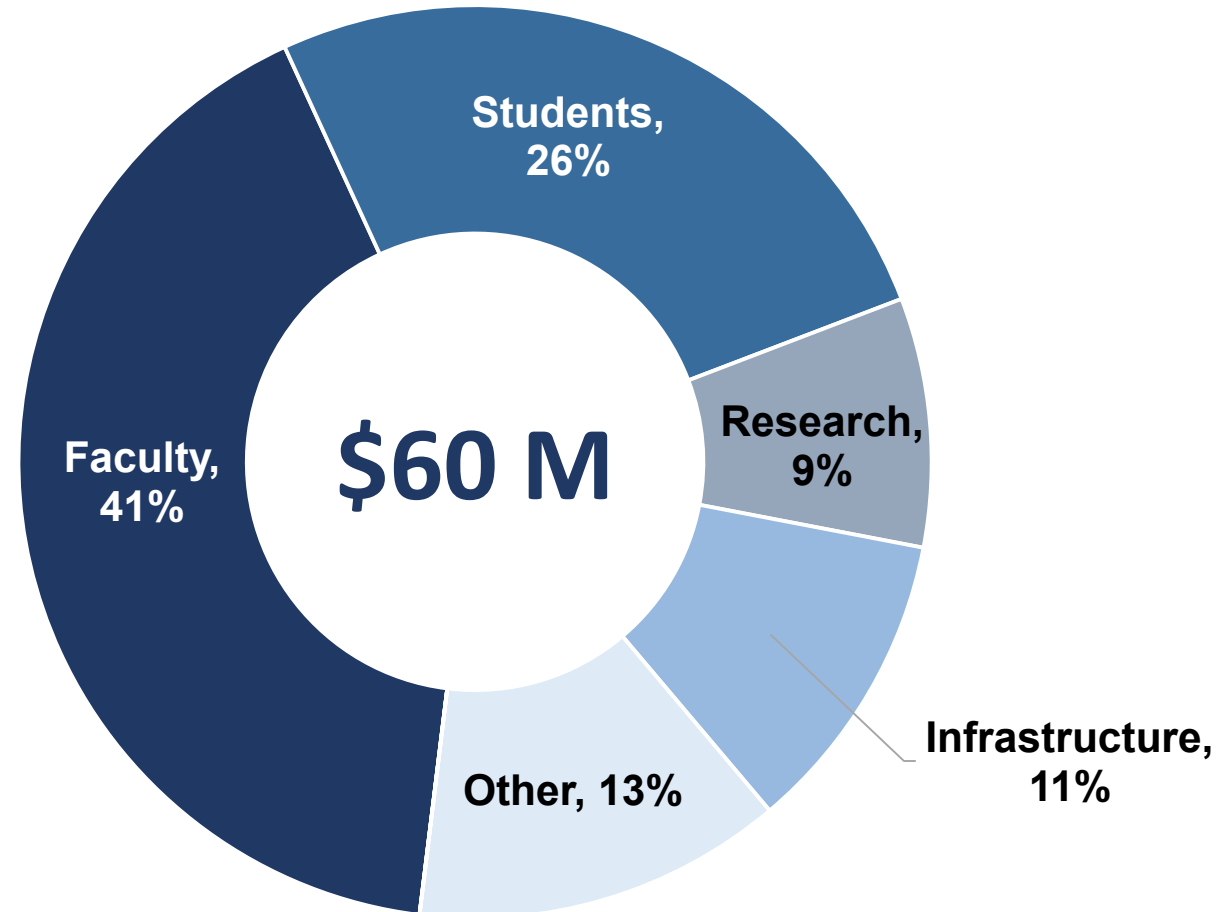
Established to support the efforts of SUS institutions to enhance the quality and excellence of professional and graduate schools in the areas of **medicine, law, and business**

Intended to expand the **economic impact** of state universities

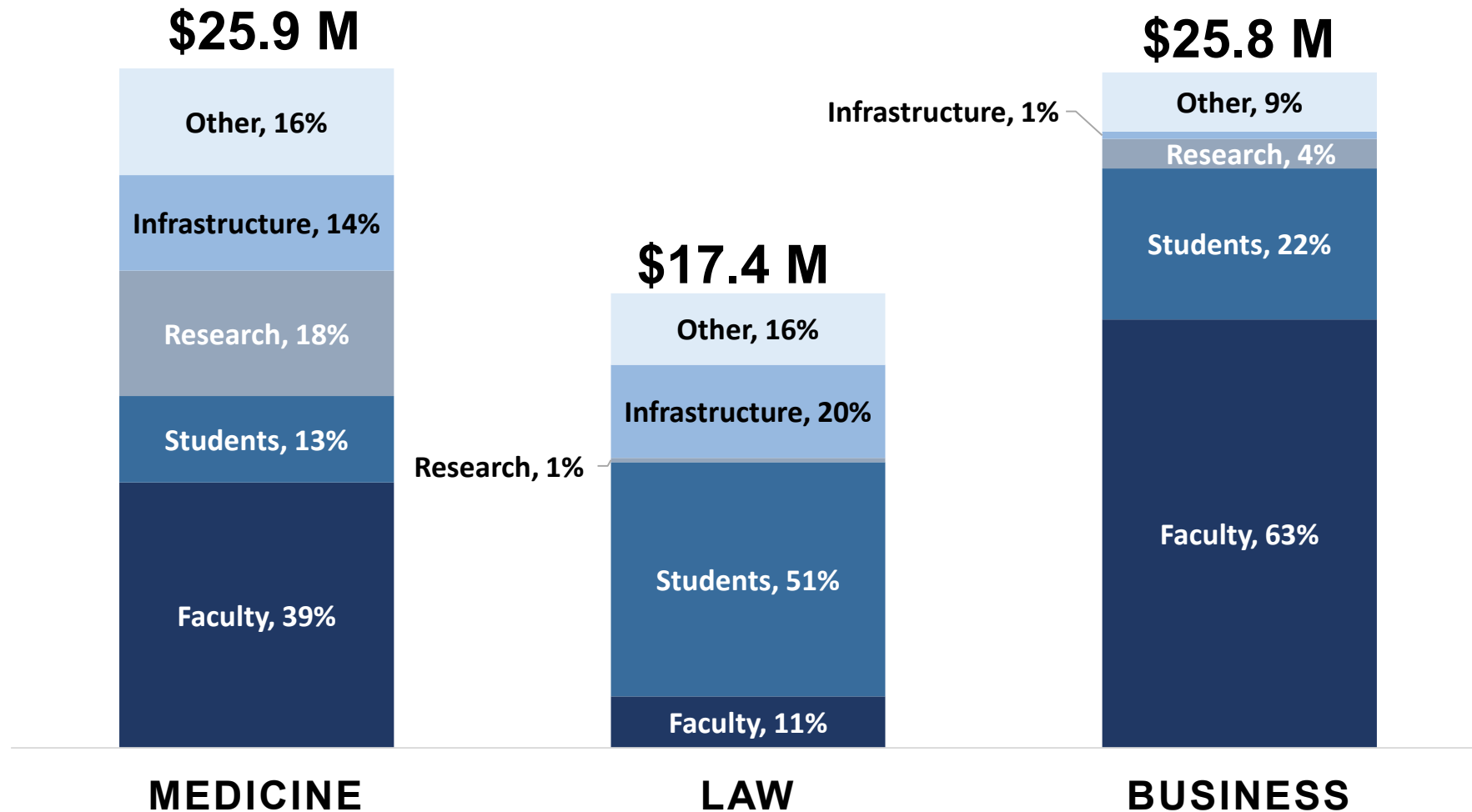


# Program 2018-19 Expenditures

## Institutions reported

- spending to **enhance & support** medical, law, & business programs
- **increasing** the % of graduate-level graduates working in Florida and earning more than \$40,000
- **advancing** in the national rankings
  - UF & FIU law schools both improved by 10 slots in one year
  - USF medical school increased in the rankings
  - FSU, UF, & USF graduate business schools also improved
