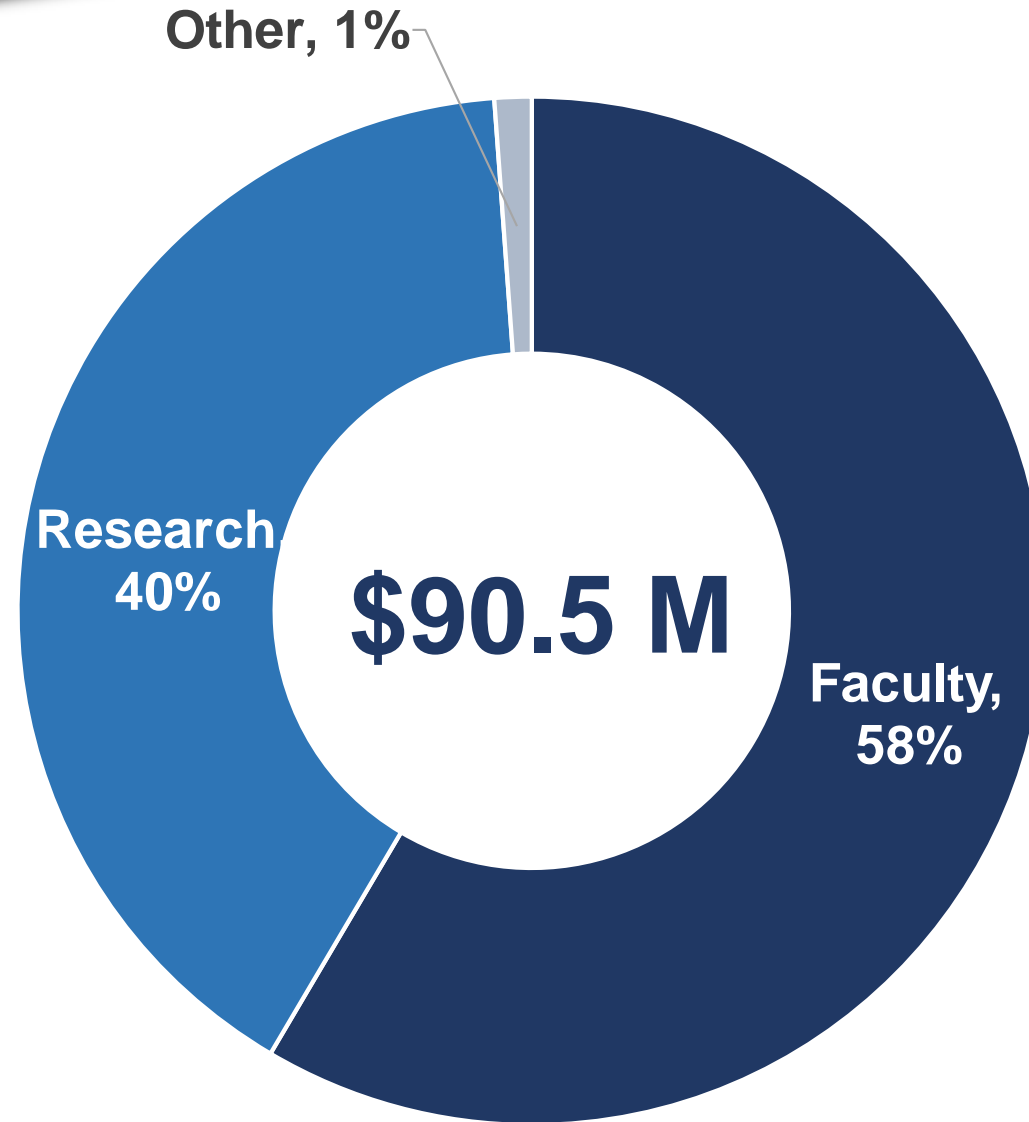
Established to support the efforts of state universities to recruit & retain **exemplary faculty & research scholars**

Institutions reported

- recruiting **217 new faculty** (FTE)
- retaining over **3,000 existing faculty** (FTE)
- improving the percent of undergraduate classes with **fewer than 50 students** to **86%**
- transferring roughly **\$37.7 million in research** funding to the institutions
- having more than **\$323 million in research** proposals under development or review

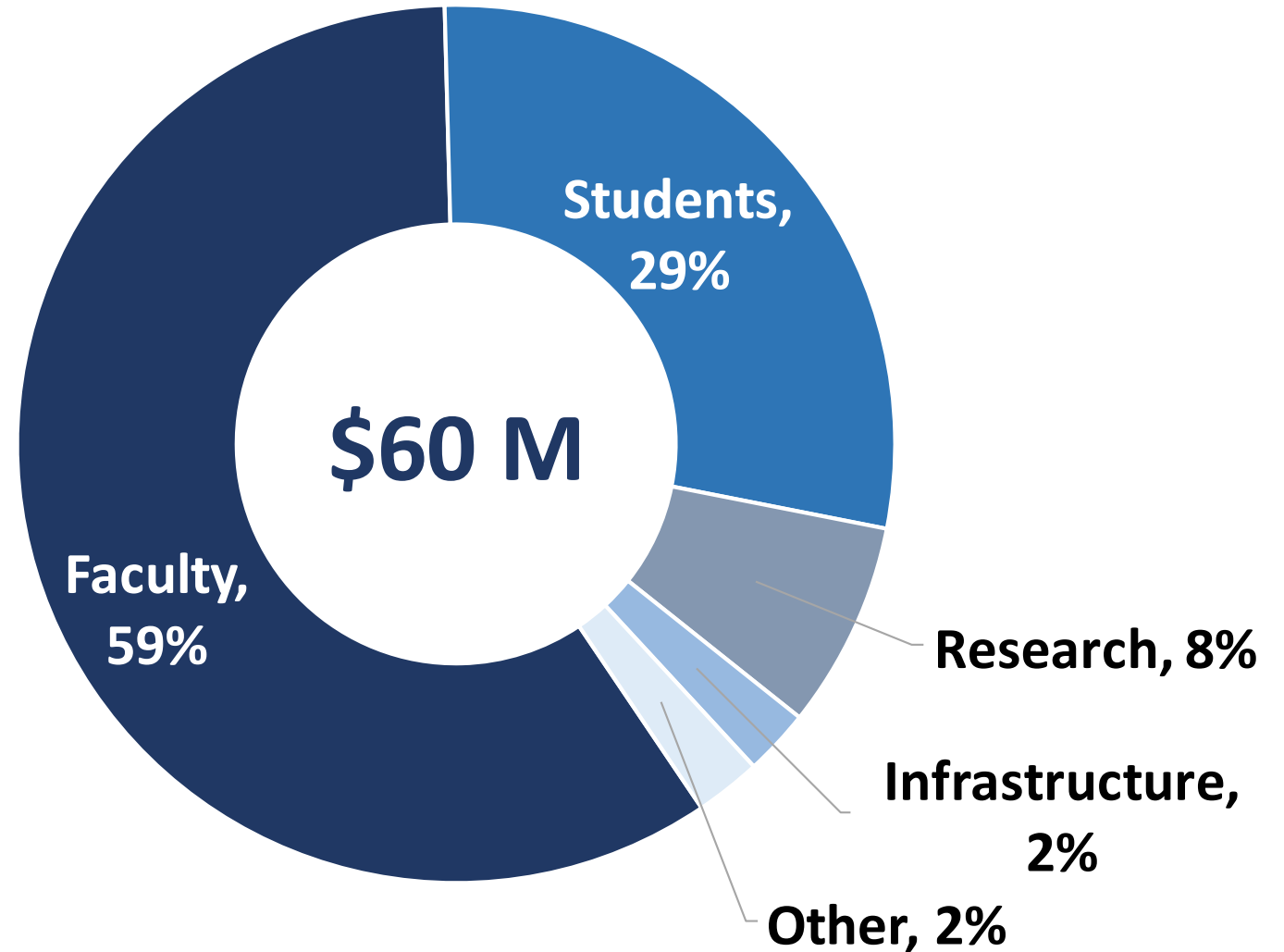
Established to support the efforts of SUS institutions to enhance the quality & excellence of professional and graduate schools in the areas of **medicine, law, & business**

Program 2019-20 Expenditures

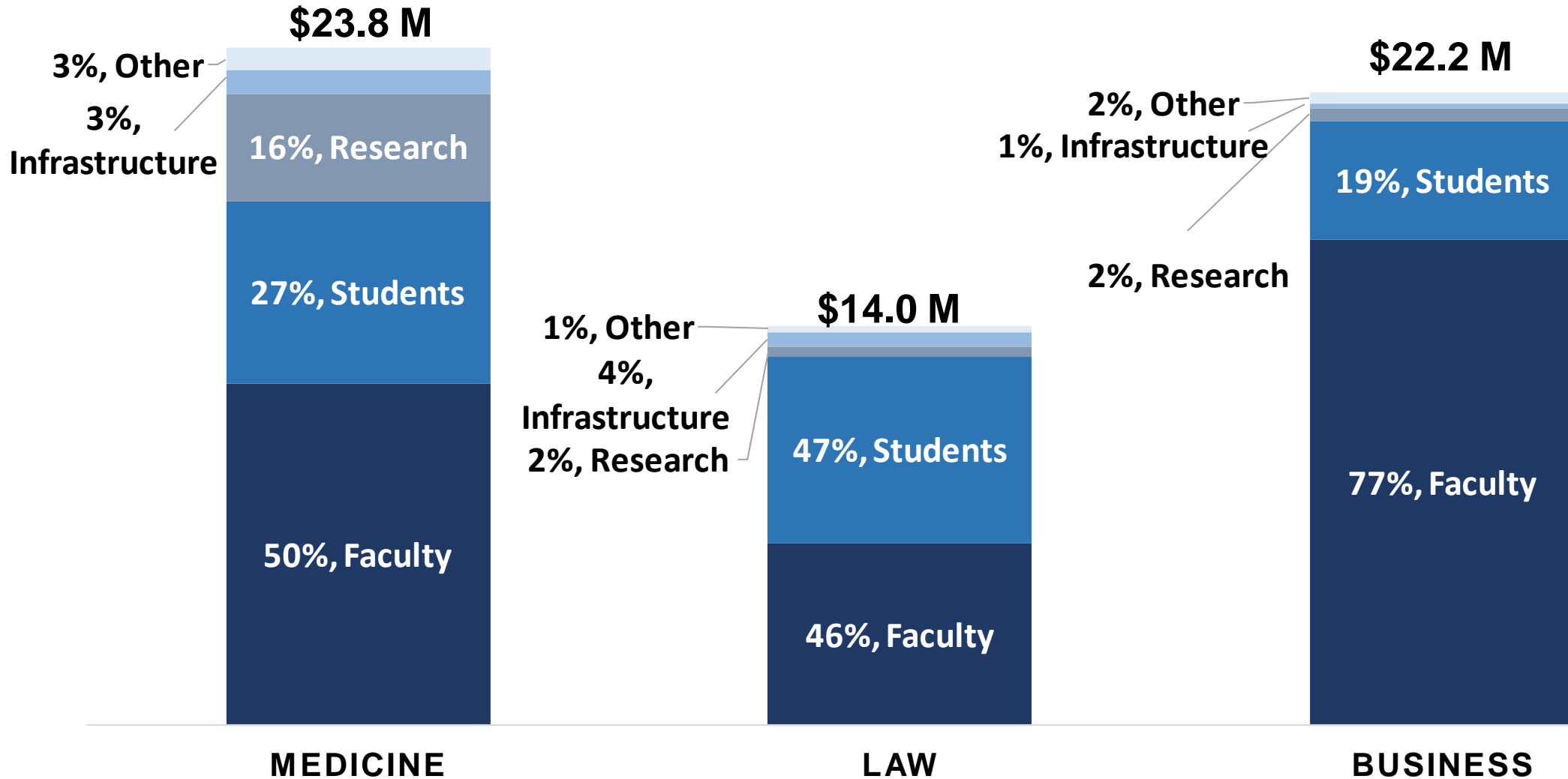


Most (88%) of the funds from the Professional & Graduate Degree Excellence Program were used to **recruit & retain faculty & support student success** initiatives
