

Proposed Noticing of Regulation 8.007-Articulation

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Constitutional Authority



The Constitution of the State of Florida, Article IX, Section 7 specifies that it is the Board of Governors responsibility to delineate each State University System institution and its articulation with public K-12 and Florida College System institutions. Doing so ensures the well-planned coordination and operation of the system and avoids wasteful duplication of facilities or programs.

Legislative Intent



Section 1007.01, Florida Statutes, specifies its intention to provide articulation between and among universities, Florida colleges, and school districts.

- Provide efficient and effective progression and transfer of students
- Allow students to proceed toward their educational goals as rapidly as possible

National Leader in Articulation



- The State University System has been a partner in statewide articulation since the establishment of the statewide articulation agreement in 1975.
- Constitutional authority of Board of Governors was established in 2003 and the Board adopted the articulation agreement in guidelines by resolution.
- Since that time, the Board has addressed a variety of articulation issues in regulation.
