BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 8.013 Limited Access authorizes the Board of Governors to consider for approval limited access status requests for baccalaureate programs.

Board of Governors Regulation 8.013 provides that baccalaureate degree programs may be approved as limited access for one or more of the following reasons:

- the number of qualified applicants exceed the program's resources and capacity,
- special skills or talent is required to be successful in the program, and
- higher academic achievement is necessary to be successful in the program.

All of the State University System institutions, except for Florida Polytechnic University and New College of Florida, currently have approved limited access programs. Institutions have submitted the annual limited access program report for the 2020-2021 academic year to the Board office.

Dr. Traki Taylor, Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic for Academic Affairs, will provide an overview of this year's reports.
