# Policy Recommendations: Process for Determining Credit



**Postsecondary institutions** identify the most common courses that students receive credit for military training



ACC & faculty discipline committees review & develop statewide list, using ACE guide for military credit



Lists go to Board of Governors & State Board for approval

**VA** identifies the most commonly completed military trainings



ACC & faculty discipline committees review & develop statewide list, using equivalency guide from ACE



# Policy Recommendations: Other Policies & Procedures



Any military student regardless of status with the military is eligible to receive credit

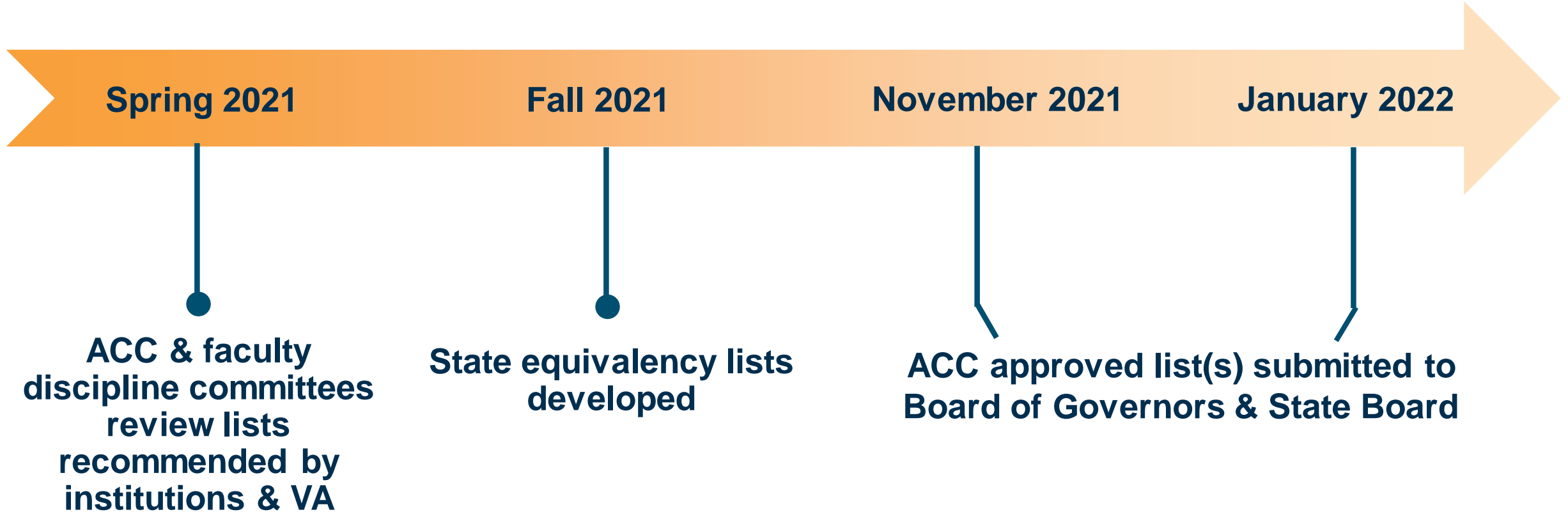
Maximum number of hours awarded to be determined based on accrediting body requirements

Each institution must develop corresponding policies that align with these recommendations, Board regulations, & statute

Institutions must continue with policies & procedures for granting credit for trainings not on the statewide list

Credit granted does NOT count towards excess hours
