<u>AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION</u>

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Board of Governors Regulation 8.003 Textbook and Instructional Materials Affordability has been amended to address changes in section 1004.085(4), Florida Statutes from the 2020 Legislative Session. The amendment requires that innovative pricing techniques and payment options for course materials include an opt-out provision in addition to the opt-in provision for students. The opt-out provision may be approved provided there is documented evidence that opting out reduces the cost of textbooks and instructional materials for students taking a course.

If approved by the Board of Governors, the Intent to Amend will be available for public comment for thirty days. If no concerns are raised during that time, the regulation will come before the Board of Governors for final approval.
