

Efforts to Increase Participation

- Club and organization certification requirement
- Hazing Prevention Summit
- Include in Onboarding Process during New Student Orientation
- Collaboration with ROTC, Athletics, and Performing Arts
- Campus Safety presentations

Regulation 6.021 requires SUS institutions to annually report the number of hazing incidents which required a disciplinary proceeding that resulted in the student or organization or group being found responsible for a hazing incident
