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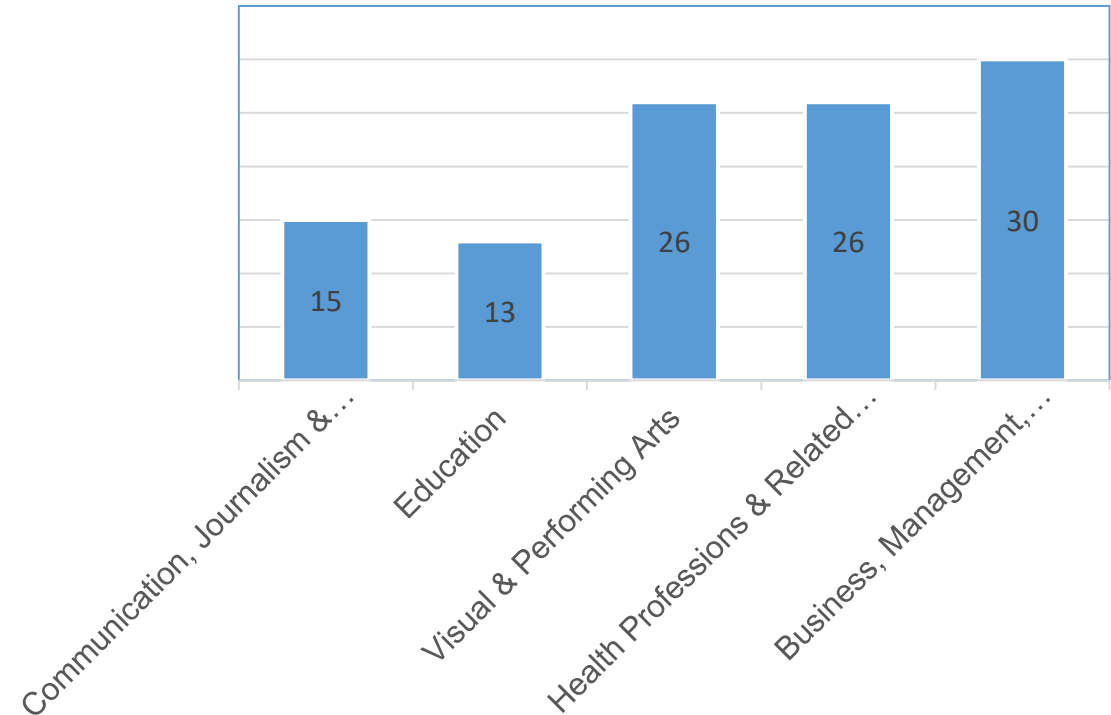

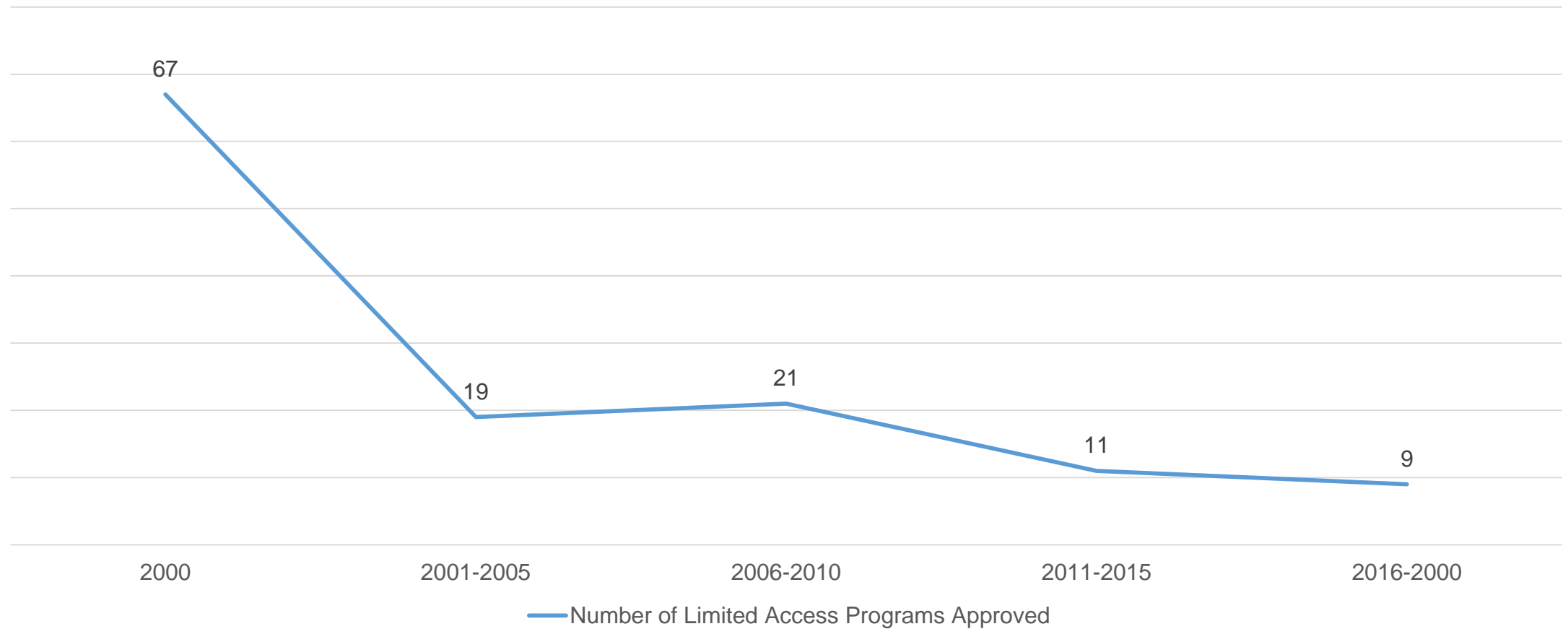

Limited Access Approvals



Programs Approved in the Last Ten Years



- 2010 – 2014
 - 20 programs approved for limited access status, with the Business, Management, Marketing, & Related Support Services 2-Digit CIP Program Area having the largest number approved

- 2015 – 2019
 - 11 programs approved for limited access status, with the Health Professions & Related Programs and the Communication, Journalism, & Related Programs 2-Digit CIP Program Areas tied for having the largest number approved

Program Reviews



- Regulation 8.013(2) requires that each limited access program undergo a review as part of the university's cyclical program review process to determine if there is still a need for the program to maintain limited access status
- Completed every seven years- aligned with regional & discipline-specific accreditation requirements
- Analyzes the ways degree programs provide high quality education for students while preparing them for success in a global economy
- Emphasis on the assessment of student learning outcomes & continuous program improvement
- The Board requested a 2-3 year follow-up after each limited access approval



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
