#### PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

Review and validate the completed FAMU Educational Plant Survey.

#### **AUTHORITY FOR BOARD OF GOVERNORS ACTION**

Article IX, Section 7, Florida Constitution; Sections 1013.03 and 1013.31, Florida Statutes

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

An EPS (or Survey) is required at least once every five (5) years for all public educational entities, including universities. At the request of FAMU, Board staff helped facilitate and coordinate the Survey process, and participated on the Survey Team, to help ensure the requirements of section 1013.31, F.S. were satisfied. The Survey Team also included staff from Florida International University, New College of Florida, University of Central Florida, and the University of Florida.

The EPS covers the period July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2025, and represents FAMU's first Survey completed using the Dynamic Capital Planning (DCP) model (i.e. standardized universally-applied space factors). An overview of FAMU's projected total space needs and survey-recommended additional space is reflected in the chart below.
