

Lower costs to students, a 60% reduction in the last 5 years




\$400+ million in research expenditures

^{*}This goal was modified in October of 2019 to include a wage threshold of \$30,000 and a goal of 80%.


Median Wages of Bachelor's Graduates Employed Full-Time











Academic Progress Rate








FTIC 4-year Graduation Rate








Pell Recipient 4-year Graduation Rate



AA FCS Transfer 3-year Graduation Rate









Bachelor's Degrees Awarded






Graduate Degrees Awarded


Total Research Expenditures (Millions)

Enrollment Trends

- While # of **new FTIC** has grown over the last 5 years, it has slowed down in recent years (2% change in last year)
- The # of returning FTIC students has increased, due to improved student success initiatives
- The # of FCS AA Transfer students has declined slightly in the last 5 years
- Overall System undergrad enrollment has grown 4% in the last 5 years
