Faculty Resources: 20% (class size, faculty salary, faculty w/ terminal degree, student-faculty ratio, % of faculty full-time)

Expert Opinion: 20% (peer assessments: presidents, provosts, admit. deans)

Financial Resources: 10% (Avg. per student spending)

Student Excellence: 10% (ACT/SAT, top 10% of HS class)

Alumni Giving: 5% (% of alumni w/ BA degrees)

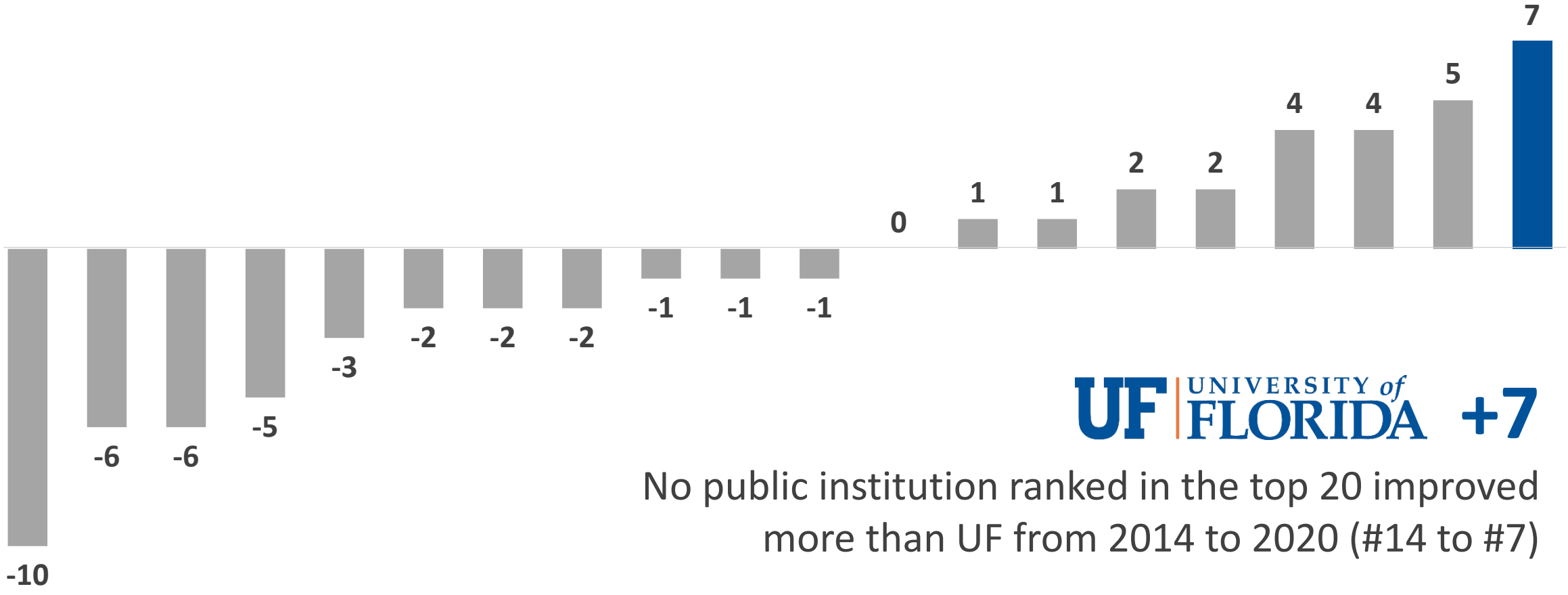

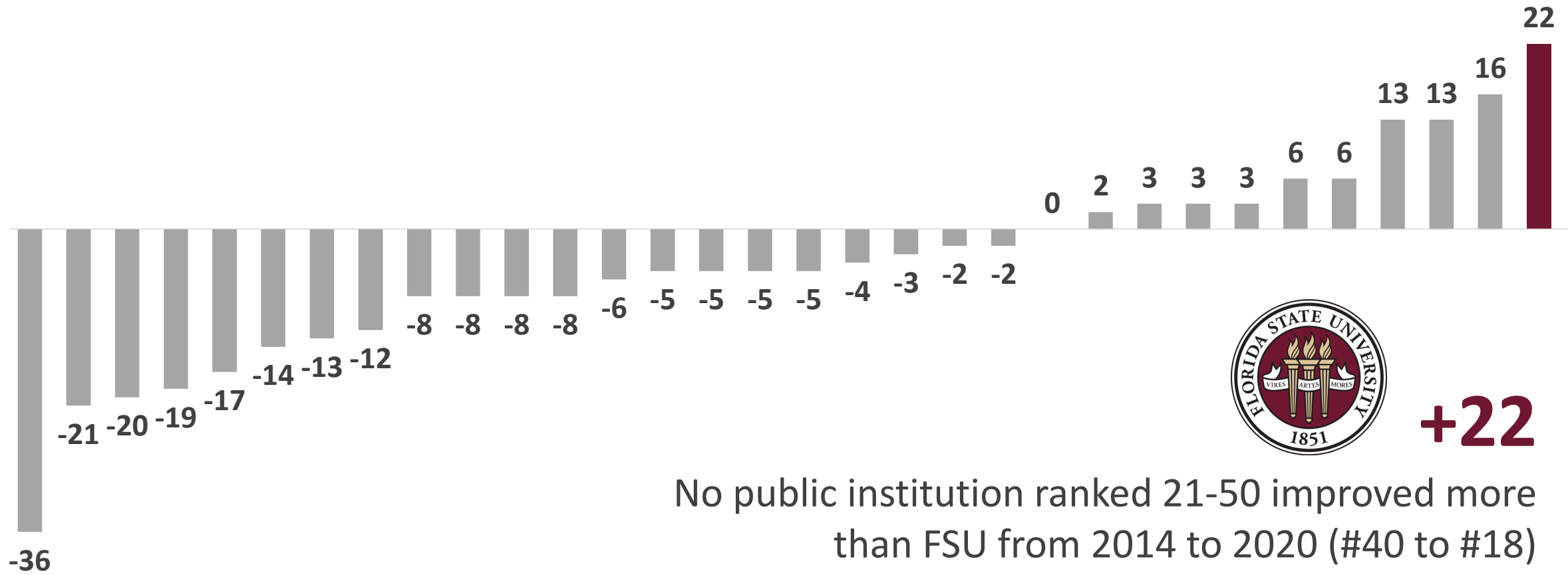

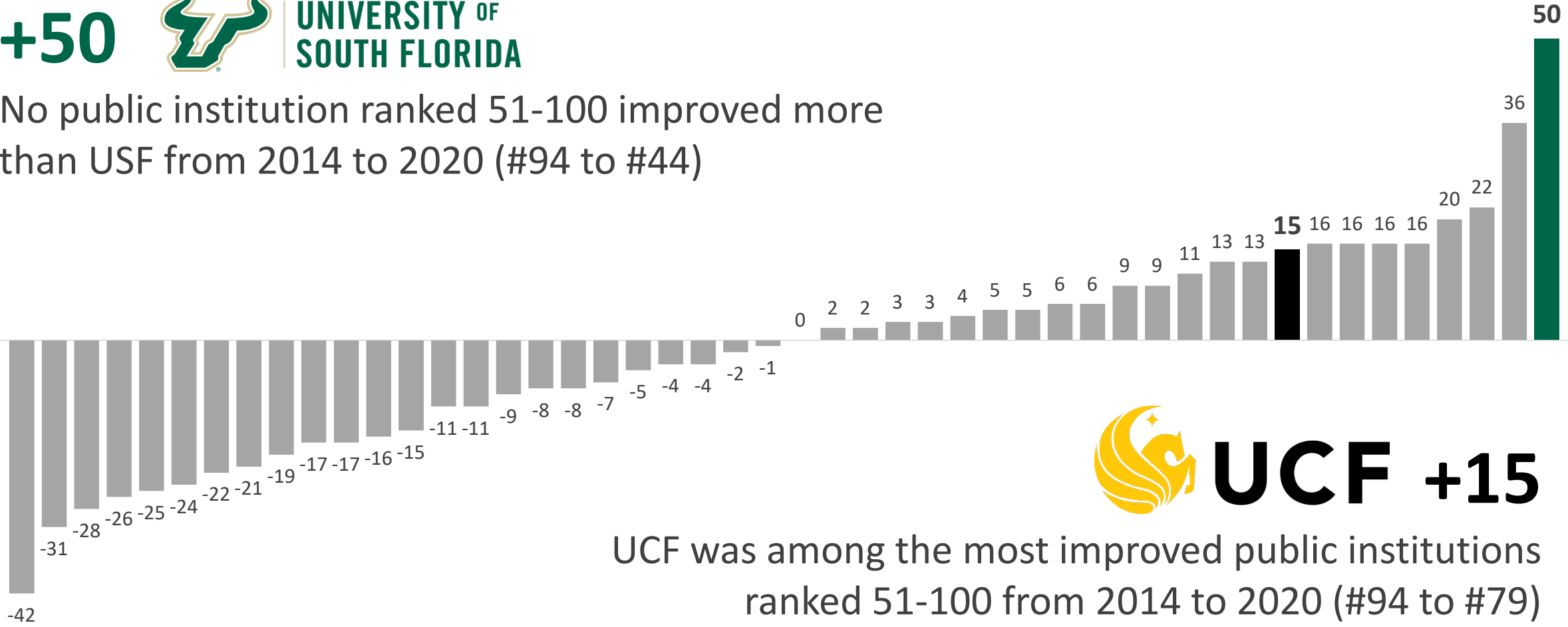

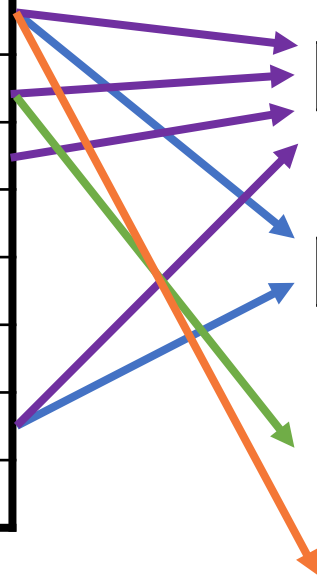
