BACKGROUND INFORMATION

An essential component of the Board's 2025 Strategic Plan is the list of Programs of Strategic Emphasis (PSE). The PSE list exists as one of several tools for aligning the degree production goals of the State University System (SUS) with the economic and workforce needs of Florida, and it is a component of the Performance Based Funding Model. Every ten years, the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) is updated by the U.S. Department of Education's National Center for Education Statistics, which necessitates a review of the PSE list to ensure continued alignment with the current workforce needs of Florida.

SUS institutions reviewed and commented on proposed revisions and feedback was included, where appropriate, into the current recommendations.

Mr. Roger Strickland, Director of Economic Development, will present the Committee with the recommended changes to the PSE list based on the CIP 2020 changes for approval. If approved, Programs of Strategic Emphasis: CIP 2020 Update will go to the Full Board for approval. If approved by the Full Board, Programs of Strategic Emphasis: CIP 2020 Update will go into effect with the 2020-21 academic year.
