BACKGROUND INFORMATION

At its May 28, 2020 meeting, the Strategic Planning Committee received an update on university performance on the performance based funding metrics. Part of the presentation showed that over the past five years, both Florida State University and the University of Florida have experienced declining University Access Rates and are below the System's goal of 30%. The access rate metric is the percentage of undergraduates enrolled in the fall term who received a Pell grant. The purpose of this metric is to ensure that the System continues to provide opportunities to students from all socioeconomic levels. The Committee Chair requested that Florida State University and the University of Florida provide additional information on this metric to the Strategic Planning Committee.

University representatives from the University of Florida and Florida State University will provide an update to the Committee.
