**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This is the fifth report to the Board of Governors on the employment and education outcomes of baccalaureate degree recipients. This study examines employment and education outcomes of baccalaureate graduates one, five, and ten years after graduation. The study addresses the following questions.

1. Do graduates get jobs?
2. Do graduates earn additional credentials?
3. What are the salaries of graduates over time?
