Dollin's Growth - Stages of Development

- Birth to one month, oral communication, like crying, cooing
- 2 to 3 months, respond to sounds, vision, baby talk, reciprocal + imitative
- 4 to 6 months, babbling, focus on vowels + consonants, sounds, head up
- 6 to 9 months, repeating sounds to make words, focusing on oral communication
- 10 to 12 months, expressive + receptive words, nonverbal gestures, focus on gestures, nonverbal focus
- 13 to 18 months, expand words, language focus
- 19 to 24 months, language focus, language focus

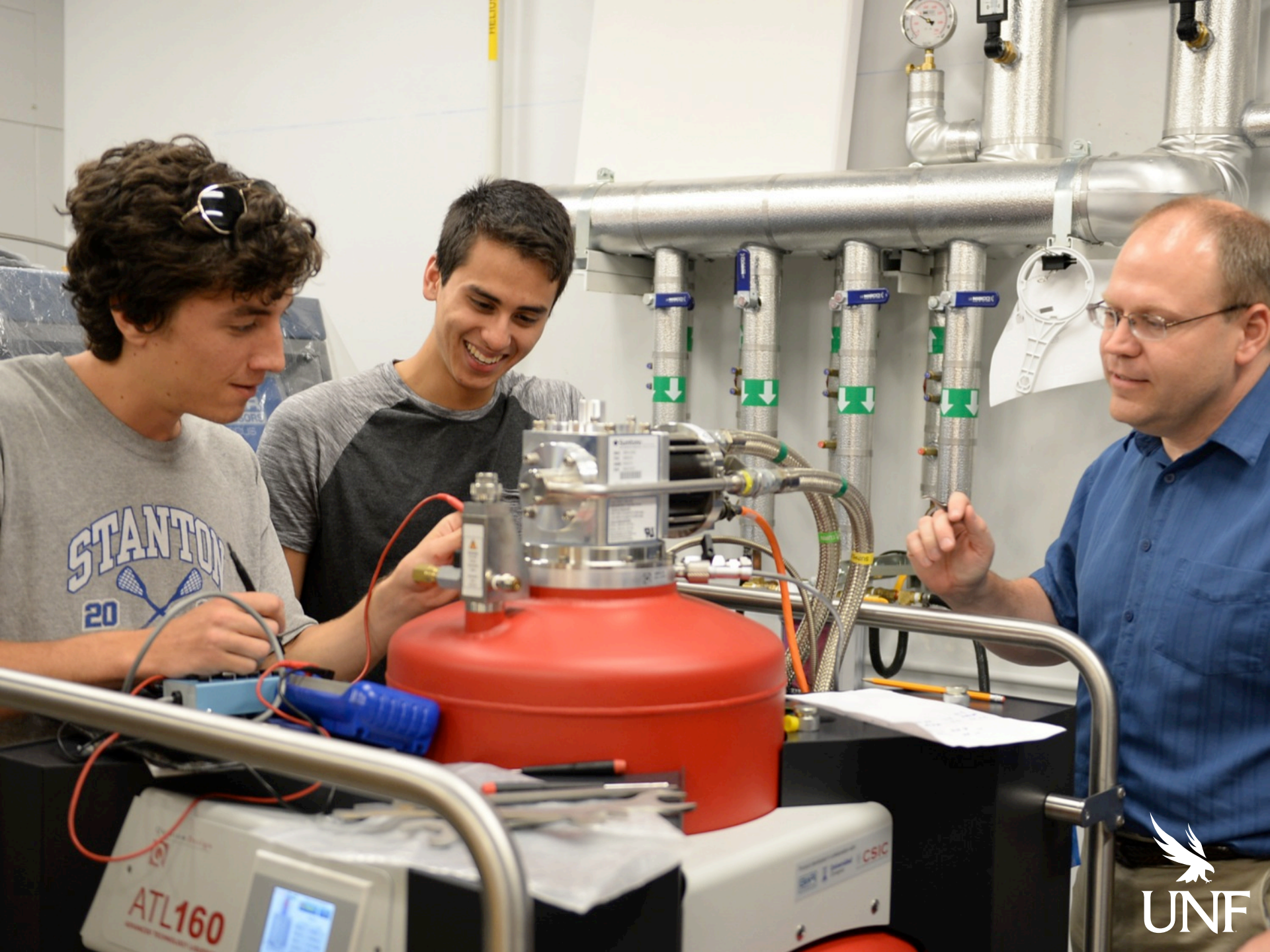

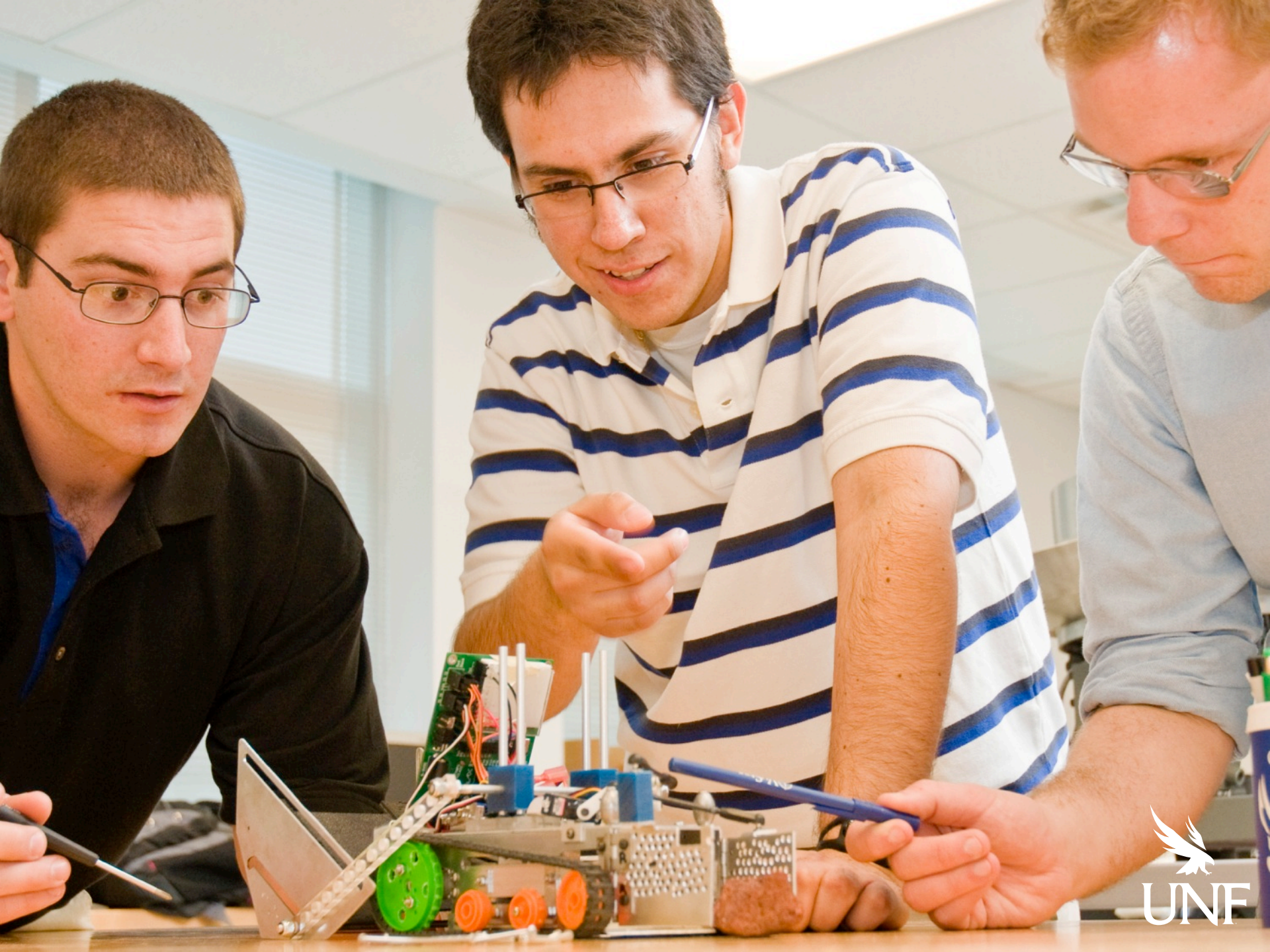






UNF will host an AVID
